### **Community Relations Manager update**

Oliva described all the different elements of construction update we could be sharing with the public.

Linda called out that construction pace is very volatile and we cannot, with any accuracy, share our construction pace.

Bruce asked if, when there is a flurry of construction activity, we should be reaching out to customers in a specific DA. Chuck echo'd this and proposed we have a quarterly mass update but giving some in-construction DA more detail.

Linda pointed out that the number of installations per week is also unpredictable and slow.

Bruce called out that customers don't know the terms of CUDs, DAs, etc. People just want to know when Internet will be available in Middlesex.

Linda reiterated that pace is far too slow to publish week by week data. Chuck agreed and just wanted a current state snapshot.

Olivia indicated she had the directional guidance she needed.
