Chris then briefly went over what has changed, indicating that the changes move NEKCV in line with the changes made for federal grants, to the different tiers for purchasing. He advised that the dollar benchmarks have all risen in recent years and the changes to the Procurement Policy moves us to be in line to be compliant with federal grant revenues.

Mid-Year Operational Update

Executive session was entered at 5:39pm and ended at 6:36pm. No action was taken in executive session and nothing discussed in the session was suitable to put on the record, except the motion to exit executive session, that was moved by Jeremy Matt and seconded by Chuck Burt.

Discussion Summary: Staff presented the highlights from the operational update that were suitable to be presented publicly. Chris went over the construction updates, indicating OLT's in progress in Barnet, Canaan, Bloomfield, Charleston and Coventry and construction in progress in an extensive list of towns, shown in the slides presented. Service expansion is currently underway in Derby, Holland, Concord, Victory and Granby, many through the ReConnect grant. He then touched on some of the recent product updates, including the 50/50 for \$59, \$30 monthly discount available through Equity Connect Program and that we are still accepting Ziiip applications. Additionally, he shared company milestones of surpassing 2,500+ customers and the Groton HUB being open and active. Chris continued by sharing some of the recent Community Outreach events and engagement. Lastly, Chris briefly shared some of the current open positions at NEKCV and encouraged the board members to send any qualified candidates our way. The positions that have been recently filled were also shown.

Additionally, Nick encouraged board members to check out VT Speed Check, briefly describing the purpose and encouraging board members to use it and report back on their experience using it. A link to a related documentary film was also provided.

Framework for Non-subscription Revenues

Tom briefly went over the thought process behind the document to be reviewed and discussed in the Breakout Group Sessions, Framework for Non-subscription Revenues.



This came about after discussion at the last Governing Board meeting surrounding non-customer driven revenue opportunities and how the board could evaluate that type of opportunity in the future. The framework put forth provides some points to consider, as well as a way of considering and evaluating different aspects of potential non-subscriber business ventures and revenue streams. Nick added that he appreciates that this is pretty high-level and would provide questions that should be asked when considering ventures in the future, without being too prescriptive.

The board then broke out into six breakout groups to discuss and provide feedback within a provided link to document feedback and notes from the discussions. The breakout rooms were closed at 7pm and board members brought back to the meeting. Nick advised that we would put together the notes and discuss at a future Executive Committee meeting and invited board members to attend.

Nick also mentioned that we have a resignation on the Executive Committee and encouraged anyone that may be interested in filling that slot to email him to discuss.

Kitty then spoke up to remind everyone that the next Governing Board meeting will be the once-a-year, in-person meeting on Saturday, October 24th in the Moore Community Room on the Lyndon Campus of Vermont State University.
